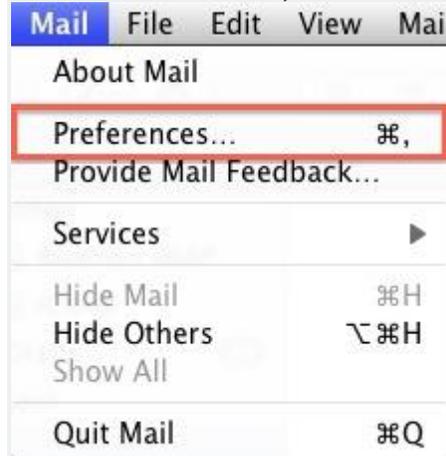


# EMAIL SETUP FOR APPLE MAIL

(Updated October, 2018)

This tutorial will step you through configuring your email address in Apple Mail for Mac.

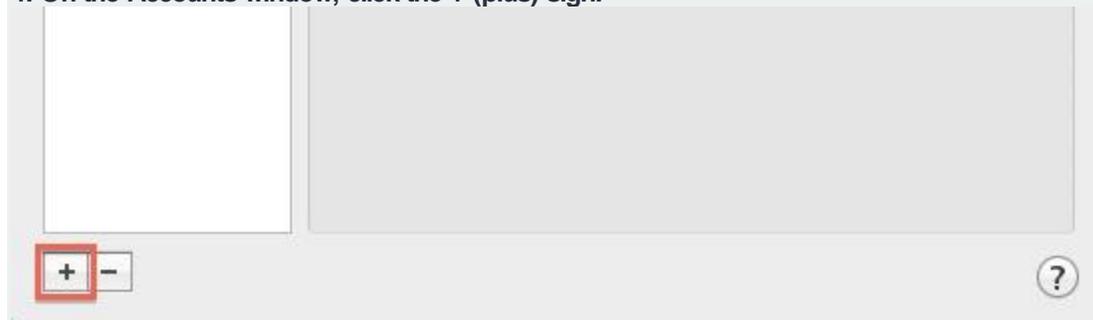
1. Choose Preferences, from the Mail menu.



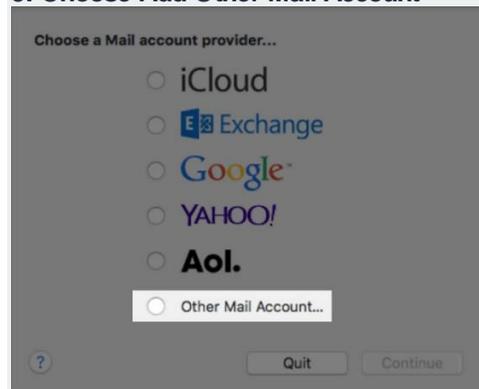
2. Select Preferences.

3. Click on the Accounts tab.

4. On the Accounts window, click the + (plus) sign.



5. Choose Add Other Mail Account



6. Enter your Full Name, or as you would like it to appear on your sent email.

**Add a Mail Account**

To get started, provide the following information:

Account must be manually configured

7. Enter your Email Address.

8. Enter your email account's Password.

9. Click the Continue button.

10. A message should appear saying "Account must be manually configured". Click Next.

11. Choose your account type. You may select either POP or IMAP.

12. Please enter my.serverhost.com.au as the Incoming mail server, replacing example.com

13. Enter your full email address as the User Name.

14. Enter the Password of your email account.

15. Click Next.

16. The Outgoing Mail Server is the same as your incoming mail server. Again, this will be my.serverhost.com.au

17. Enter your full email address as the User Name.

18. Enter the Password of your email account.

19. You may receive a message saying Additional account information required.

20. For the port number, you can use port port 465 with SSL.

21. Make sure the Authentication is set to Password.

22. Click the Create button.
